ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$58.30.** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT.

OBEDIENCE TRIAL – July 10, 2009

The following obedience classes will be offered: Novice A; Novice B; Open A; Open B; Utility; Pre-Novice, Novice C, Novice Intermediate, Team, Brace, Versatility & Veterans. **Please ensure jump height is indicated on entry form for Open, Utility, Novice Intermediate and Versatility.**

Regular Obedience Classes

Novice A for any purebred dog that has not earned the title of CD. Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner or member of his immediate family. No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously handled a dog through its UD title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in this class.

Novice B for any purebred dog that has not earned the title of CD in CANADA. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the 'sit' and 'down' exercise. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is eligible for this class.

Open A for any purebred dog that has earned the title of CD but has not won the title of CDX. Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously handled a dog through its UD title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in this class.

Open B for any purebred dog that has earned the title of CD, CDX or UD in CANADA. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the 'sit' and 'down' exercise. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is eligible for this class. A dog may be entered in both Open A and Open B at any one trial.

Utility for any purebred dog that has earned the title of CDX in CANADA.

Exhibition Only Obedience For dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the CKC.

Transition Obedience Class (Scores earned by dogs entered in Transition Classes are not eligible for High in Trial.)

Pre-Novice For any purebred dog that has not earned the PCD or CD title. Dogs may be handled by the owner or any other person and a person may enter more than one dog in this class but must have an additional handler for each dog when judged together in Group Exercise.

Novice Intermediate For any purebred dog that has earned the CD, CDX, UD or any other advanced obedience title. Dogs may be handled by the owner or any other person and a person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Novice C For any purebred dog that has earned the CD, CDX, UD or any other advanced obedience title. Dogs may be handled by the owner or any other person and a person may enter more than one dog in this class but must have an additional handler for each dog when judged together in Group Exercise.

Unofficial Obedience Classes PLEASE NOTE: Dogs entered in non-regular or unofficial classes must be entered in a regular class or Exhibition Only

Brace Two dogs of either sex that have attained at least a Canadian CD title, not necessarily with the same ownership.

Team Any four dogs of either sex that have attained at least a Canadian CD title, not necessarily with the same ownership. Five dogs may be entered, one as an alternate.

Versatility Dogs which have attained the title of CDX in Canada and at least 1 leg of U.D. in Canada.

Veteran Dogs which have attained at least a Canadian CD title and are age seven years or older.

Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered in Obedience comes into season after the close of entries if a Veterinarian's Certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial) is delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the Trial. The Rottweiler Club of Canada will refund entry, recording & listing fees if the above conditions are met.

RALLY TRIAL – July 10, 2009

The following rally classes will be offered: Novice A; Novice B; Advanced A; Advanced B, Excellent A & Excellent B. **Please ensure jump height is indicated on entry form for Advanced and Excellent.**

Novice A for any purebred dog that has not earned a CKC rally title or any CKC Novice title. The dog must be handled by the owner, co-owner or member of his immediate family.

Novice B any purebred dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced class is earned. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person.

Advanced A for any purebred dog that has earned the CKC Rally Novice title but has not earned the CKC Rally Advanced title or any CKC Novice title. The dog must be handled by the owner, co-owner or member of his immediate family.

Advanced B any purebred dog that has earned the CKC Rally Novice title. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person.

Excellent A for any purebred dog that has earned the CKC Rally Advanced title but has not earned the CKC Rally Excellent title or any CKC Novice title. The dog must be handled by the owner, co-owner or member of his immediate family.

Excellent B any purebred dog that has earned the CKC Rally Advanced title. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person.

Exhibition Only Rally For dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the CKC.

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES – July 10, 2009

To compete in juvenile sweepstakes, dogs must be entered in a regular class or for specials only. ENTRY IN THE JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES FROM THE EXHIBITON ONLY CLASS IS NOT ALLOWED.

Juvenile Sweepstakes – Classes will be divided by sex as follows:

- 6 - 9 months
- 9 - 12 months
- 12 - 15 months
- 15 - 18 months

The Rottweiler Club of Canada will retain 25% of each entry fee for expenses. The remaining 75% shall be awarded as follows:

- First in each class 6% of total entry fee & ribbon
- Second, Third & Fourth in each class Ribbon
- Best in Sweepstakes 15% of total fee & rosette
- Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes 12% of total fee & rosette

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES – July 10, 2009



To compete in veteran sweepstakes, dogs need not be entered in a regular class or for specials only; they can be entered in exhibition only. ENTRY IN THE VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES FROM THE EXHIBITON ONLY CLASS IS ALLOWED. Spayed and neutered dogs may compete.

Veteran Sweepstakes – Classes will be divided by sex as follows:

- 7 -9 years
- 9 – 11 years
- Over 11 years

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Dog Show Rulebooks and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.42 (plus 5% GST) per copy. In Canada call toll-free 1-800-250-8040, in the United States call 1-416-675-5511.
2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Evelyn Kenny Club premium list, will also apply to this specialty.
3. Entries will be acknowledged after closing date. Receipts, judging schedules, and exhibitor's passes will be mailed. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
4. Entry fees shall not be refunded after the closing date in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
5. All dogs must be kept on leash while on the grounds. You are responsible for cleaning up when your dog relieves himself. PLEASE 'STOOP AND SCOOP' AT ALL TIMES – THANK YOU. Failure to do so may result in being expelled from the SHOW GROUNDS by the Superintendent
6. All dogs must be kept under control at all times.
7. **Exhibitors please note Chapter 19.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving specialty to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subjected to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.**
